



10th Anniversary Harp Summer School

Wednesday 24 – Saturday 27 August - Gwernyfed High School.

Because this year's summer school is the 10th, we are working to make the event special and full details will be published in due course. In the meantime we can tell you the tutor line up this year will be Eleanor Turner (our Director of Music, Classical, Contemporary and World Music), Ailie Robertson (Irish, Scottish, contemporary music and composer), Adriano Sangineto (Continental, traditional dance music and composer), Manon Browning (Classical, Traditional folk and popular music), Eleri Darkins (Classical and Welsh music) and Emily Harris (Classical Welsh Harpist). In addition, following requests last year, we have added a triple harp workshop for all participants in the overall programme to be taught by Elonwy Wright which will happen on 24 August.

Over the four days there will be five teaching groups as follows:

1. Advanced – adults, teenagers
2. Intermediate – adults
3. Intermediate -Teenagers

Tutors for these groups will be Ailie Robertson, Adriano Sangineto and Manon Browning supported by Eleanor Turner.

4 & 5 Beginners groups for: Students from Gwernyfed high school harps in schools project and young people 11 upwards from elsewhere who have achieved grades 1-2 or who are learning music at those levels.

6. Adults beginners group, for those who have achieved grades 1-2 or who are learning music at those levels.

Tutors for these three groups will come from Eleri Darkins, Emily Harris and Marged Hall.

Thursday 25 August 7.30pm 'The Story so Far' - with Catrin Finch

In the depths of the pandemic, internationally renowned harpist Catrin Finch turned 40 and, unable to perform for live audiences, reflected on her musical career as she entered a new decade. Having presented The Harp's Journey, a three-part series for BBC Radio 3 in 2021, Catrin decided to take her 35-year career on the post-COVID road in The Story So Far, an 80-minute trip through the musical life of one of the world's finest and most fearless harpists.

Join Catrin as she journeys through the adventures and sounds of the music that's most important to her, woven with anecdotes, chat and insights into the life of an extraordinary harpist. From the most sublime Claire de Lune by Debussy, through Piazzola's tangos to the fiery joropo of Colombian cowboys and serenity of traditional Welsh folk tunes, the extraordinary diversity and range of harp and harpist make for a wonderful evening in the company of Catrin Finch.
